

Little Hills Lake Management District
2022 - Special Board Meeting Minutes
Saturday, May 21, 2022 @9am

Attendance: Neal Nett, Tom Stoddard, Tom DeMeyer, Carl Veeneenaal, Francine Marshall, District member, Jim Peirce and County Representative, John Jarvis.
Meeting called to order at 9:00am.

Minutes from 2nd Quarter Board meeting approved.

Discussion on 2023 budget was the focus. Asking to raise special charge to \$250 may not be necessary with funds possibly being provided from township. Neal and Francine reported other lake bodies' dues/special charge amounts are higher than ours.

Neal will propose asking for \$100. It may need to be adjusted again next year to pay for all permits and treatments needed. At the Annual meeting Neal will present the required permits and the dire need for more funds needed to pay for them and for treating the concerning increase of Eurasian Water Milfoil. The district members will determine the final budget and they will vote to fill the one seat that will be vacant on the Board.

Francine reported watching the fish stocking of 8 buckets yellow perch and 4 buckets black crappie on May 13th, and all paid for with donations.

Since we have no ordinary high water mark officially designated, the decision was made to use a laser level to determine water height relative to sea level at the benchmark boat landing. Then, convert to water height relative to the water level in the monitoring well on Marshall's property for our record keeping.

Meeting adjourned at 9:57am.
